Terry Hopkins

Terry Hopkins was a member of the Jamestown Soccer Federation from 1980 to 1988 serving as President, Referee Administrator, Coaching and Referee Training Director, State Tournament Director 1985, Special Olympics State Tournament Director 1985, 1986. Terry served on the board during the construction of the Jamestown Soccer Complex and was President during the dedication ceremony. He coached Jamestown Soccer Federation youth teams in the recreational league from 1980 through 1986.

When the North Dakota Youth Soccer Association (NDYSA) was formed Terry was involved with establishing a traveling competitive soccer program at Jamestown and coached both U-12 and U-14 boys teams in this program. The U-12 team was the North Dakota State NDYSA champions in 1986, further competing in the Regional Tournament.

In 1988, Terry's employment moved him to Fargo, North Dakota. Terry was a member of the coaching staff for Red River Soccer Club. He coached a U-14 boys' team to a NDYSA State Championship also, going on to playing in the Regional 2 USYSA Tournament. He continued to coach for Red River for 3 more years, helping to develop players for the growing high school program. Eventually, this high school program was recognized by the North Dakota High School Activities Association and
