Terry Schneweis while serving in the United States Air Force was stationed in Germany. While there his sons became involved in soccer. That lead to a love for the game that Terry brought with him to the greater Grand Forks area when he was stationed at the Grand Forks Air Force base. He played a vital role in the growth of soccer in the Greater Grand Forks Area and throughout the state of North Dakota. Terry was a founding Board Member for Sunflake Soccer (Recreational Soccer). He served as Northeast Commissioner for the North Dakota Youth Soccer Association (NDYSA).

Terry worked with other NDYSA Board and Club Members to get High School Soccer as a sanctioned sport by the North Dakota High School Activities Association. Perhaps his biggest impact on the game was as the second Executive Director (serving over 16 years) for NDYSA which later changed its name to the North Dakota Soccer Association (NDSA). Terry also was a referee for over 18 year referee, refereeing over 1,400 soccer games at the local rec level, summer tournaments, high school and NCAA colleges in North Dakota and western Minnesota. He refereed at 13 boys or girls High School State Tournaments.

- 1991-1993 Founding Board Member for newly formed Sunflake Soccer. The recreational club initially registering 180 players from Grand Forks and East Grand Forks. Today Sunflake Soccer register about 800 players annually and East Grand Forks registers 300 players annually
- 1994-1996 Founding member of Grand Forks Middle School Soccer Club. Club was formed to provide sanctioned soccer opportunities for 5 middle schools in Grand Forks area. Club was dissolved when an agreement was reached to have the Grand Forks Public Schools take over the program as part of their participation in the North Dakota High School Activities Association
